## Agreement Ministry and Sector

- Agreement on ambitions, objectives and measures on five priorities;
  - 1. Results-oriented approach**
  - 2. Quality of Teaching (differentiation in class)**
  - 3. HRM Policy, ambitious culture**
  - 4. Excellence & Highly Gifted Students**
  - 5. Science & Technology**
- Schools should enjoy the autonomy to translate national priorities into their own schoolpolicy

## Translate national priorities to school policy

- School aan Zet as support organization for all five priorities
- Programme 2012 – 2015
- School aan Zet mandated and financed by the Ministry of Education
  
- School aan Zet works with schools and their boards to achieve better performances
  
- **AMBITIONS:** stimulate and support schools defining their own ambitions
- **DEVELOP and CONNECT:** develop new expertise and knowledge, share with peers
- **PERFORM:** monitor, reflect, get insight on national developments

# Number of Participants

- **Target participating schools 2012-2015:**

- 3000 Elementary Schools (out of 7000)
- 450 Vocational/High Schools (out of 800)
- 150 Special (Needs) Education Schools

Starting in 3 tranches.

- **Applications tranche I (starting spring 2012):**

- Elementary: 1099
- Vocational/High: 338
- Speciaal Education: 74





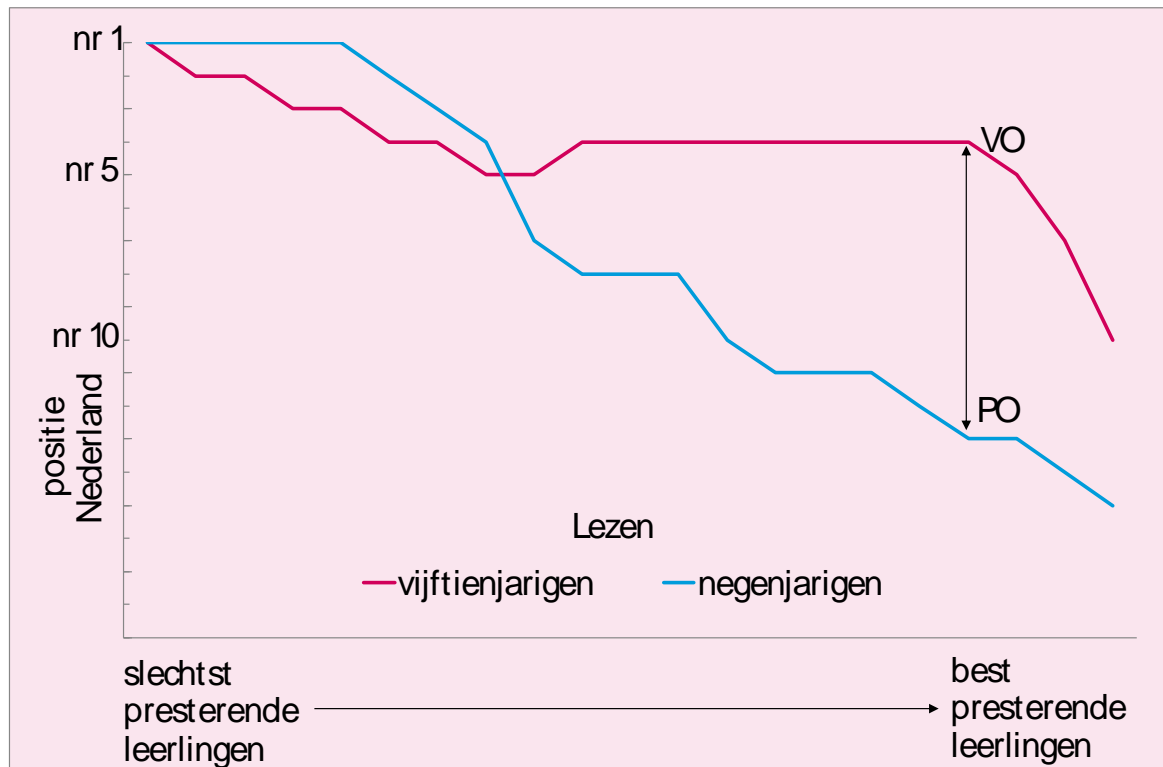

# Excellence and Highly Gifted

- **National objective:**

*Performances of the 20% best students in pre-university schools should increase with 0.2 points (i.e. GPA 3.9 increase to GPA 4.1 central exams results)*

- **School aan Zet objective**

*Each participating school should be able to define its 20% best students, be able to provide them with challenging education that fits their needs, and should be able to monitor the effects.*

- **Individual school objective**

*..... (depends on school specific context and performances)*
